PASTOR MIKE'S COLUMN

Encouragement from the Prophet Jeremiah - by Pastor Mike.

There are some times in life where we just have to make the best of what we can do in a bad situation. During the days of the Prophet Jeremiah, Jerusalem had basically been invaded and destroyed by Nebuchadnezzar and his mighty army.

Most of the population were taken captive by the army and marched all the way back to Babylon, where they would have to stay for 70 years. Not only were the Jews under the discipline of the Babylonians, more than that they were under the discipline of Almighty God. But that didn't mean Jeremiah had to stop doing his ministry! Now, more than ever, the people were willing to listen to the Prophet.

In Jeremiah chapter 29, we read that the Prophet wrote letters to the Jews in captivity...

"These are the words of the letter that Jeremiah the prophet sent from Jerusalem to the surviving elders of the exiles, and to the priests, the prophets, and all the people, whom Nebuchadnezzar had taken into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon." - Jeremiah 29:1

Jeremiah tells the Jews in Babylon to build houses and plant gardens, to marry and have children, and to "seek the peace of the city" in which they were living. (29:6-7). In a general sense, Jeremiah was telling the people how to make the best of a bad situation!

Verse 11 has one of the Bible's great promises: "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope." - Jeremiah 29:11

This promise gives 3 great assurances of the character of God for us.

- 1. The first assurance is the *omniscience* of God. He says "I know the plans I have for you." God knows everything, he knows all about you, and even during the hard times in life, His plans and purposes for you as a follower of Jesus Christ, don't change. So let us also maintain to stay close to God.
- 2. The promise also shows us the *beneficence* of God, that is His kindness. He says "My plans are of peace, not of evil." God's plan for His people is good. Indeed the Book of Romans tells us that "All things work together for good, for them who love God and are called according to His purpose." So always remember the goodness of the Lord.
- 3. Thirdly this promise shows us God's *transcendence*. This means that God sees what we don't see, and does what we can't do. God knows the future. So let us trust our future into the hands of our loving Lord!

Now look at this amazing statement that God gave Jeremiah to write:

"Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will hear you. You will seek me and find me, when you seek me with all your heart." - Jeremiah 29:12-13

This is how God wants His people to make the best of a difficult situation and to be strengthened in faith and trust for the Lord...call upon the Lord, come and pray to Him for He will hear you, in seeking Him you will find Him...when we do so with all our heart!

These truths do not change according to changing situations in our lives, they are always true, because God is always true to who He is. What sure and steadfast confidence that we can have in our God, the God of the Bible.

Moving Forward

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! I thank God for making me & my family to stand as a testimony of the work of His hands.

The sudden closure of international borders and the country-wide lockdown raised uncertainty on my studies, my finances and my family who were stuck overseas. My wife was due for her 2nd delivery in May and the thought that I could not be with her during those times haunted me every day & night ever since the border closure. I had only few months left to save the required funds for my visa, which went for a toss with the lockdown. There were no one to support my elderly parents back at their place. These uncertainties weakened me and I doubted myself if I would be able to complete my studies. But! I believed in God at all times that He is able to do exceedingly and abundantly above all that I could ask or even think off. I trusted what ever situation I am in today is not a mistake of His hands and believed He has greater plans for us. Everyday whenever I was weak, I used to sing "He did not bring us out this far to take use back again" and "Giants, do die. The bigger they are, the harder they fall", believing in Him that He is bigger than my needs and the problems around me.

I told God what my concerns were and He helped us move forward above and beyond in everything that I asked for. At the end of the first week of lockdown, my employer called me and informed that he will pay me in full even though would be paid lesser through the subsidy. Also to my surprise, my hourly wage was increased to a higher rate which I had not asked for or even thought about. My parents wanting to help me decided to take a loan. I was unhappy to burden them and prayed hoping our God would meet our needs through other ways. Though my father was not eligible for wage subsidy, through faith my mother submitted an application on his behalf and prayed for a 200% increase of funds than what he was eligible. Our Lord was kind! As we read in John 6, not only was the people filled but also the disciples were able to take an excess of the blessing. Our Lord granted us 200% more than what my mother had prayed for, which not only was above and beyond my requirements, but also yielded an excess amount for my parents. When I submitted my visa this month, God helped me to show funds higher than what I had wished before the pandemic.

The Lord was our stronghold. He protected my father everyday at his work. As a newsdealer, he worked all day during the pandemic without a day's break. Yet our Lord did not let any pestilence to stalk him day or night. In spite of hospitals being closed and refusing to take admission for my wife's delivery, our Lord showed us way at the right time and kept us moving forward. Amidst this perilous time, God blessed us with another daughter. Even when situations turned against us, He gave my wife immense strength to endure the pain all by herself and manage both our children during these tough times. Though they were many people around the neighbour hood and my in laws being tested positive for Covid, our Lord kept my wife and our household under His wings and protected them. With extensive support and prayers from the Church and the elders, our Lord helped me in finishing my studies and fulfilling His purpose of bringing me to this land. When I look back the ways He has led us through, I couldn't be without thanking Him for all His wondrous works of His hands. Even an unprecedented pandemic could not devour what the Lord had set forth for us. I humble myself before Him, for it was not me, but He, would made all things possible and kept us moving forward.
