Chinese Congregation

"And he asked his father, How long is it ago since this came unto him? And he said, Of a child. And oft times it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but if thou canst do anything, have compassion on us, and help us. Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth. And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief. (Mark 9:21-24)

We trust in our God, but sometimes our faith may be tested by our surroundings. In moments like these, we must pray that God will give us strength no matter what life may throw at us. Our Father God loves us abundantly and is always watching over us.

Our congregation sister Lily was diagnosed with end stage cancer. This has been a challenging time for her and her family, and as a congregation we have stood by her through this ordeal. Over the past few months, we have learned about faith from our sister. Despite the diagnosis, she has exemplified peace and comfort to those around her.

Sister Lily has since flown to China to undergo further medical treatment there. Upon arrival she faced 14 days quarantine at the National Border. However, during this time her health deteriorated and had to receive urgent medical care. Thankfully God answered our prayers and she was able to be accepted for treatment by a hospital in Guangzhou. She completed her quarantine in hospital and was able to be admitted straight into the cancer hospital in her home city Shenyang. While overseas she still joins us for church online via zoom when she is able.

Even as she goes through this journey, she has remained strong in her faith, and her faith has seen God open doors for her to access the care she needs. She has now completed her second course of chemotherapy. While her body is still weak, we pray that God will be with her and bring her strength.

We thank you all for your ongoing prayer for sister Lily. And may we continue to pray for her and her family.

Coming up on our calendar is Christmas!

We will be having our Christmas service at 4pm on Christmas day at OCBC followed by a shared dinner and celebrations. We warmly invite all our family, friends and neighbours to join us as we celebrate the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ!

From the 21 -23rd of December we are also running a youth camp, outreaching to international students studying in New Zealand. We pray that this camp will be a blessing to them and build their faith in Jesus.

Praise our heavenly Father. He is an amazing God and may his blessing be with each and every one of our brothers and sisters in 2020. May he continue to guide us into 2021!
